






PATIENT CENTERED MEDICAL HOME (PCMH)

- The PCMH serves as the patient's primary "hub" and coordinator of healthcare delivery. Patient care is coordinated and provided through a person-centered, team-based approach with a focus on prevention and wellness within the context of services available outside the clinic setting to address a person's total health needs.
