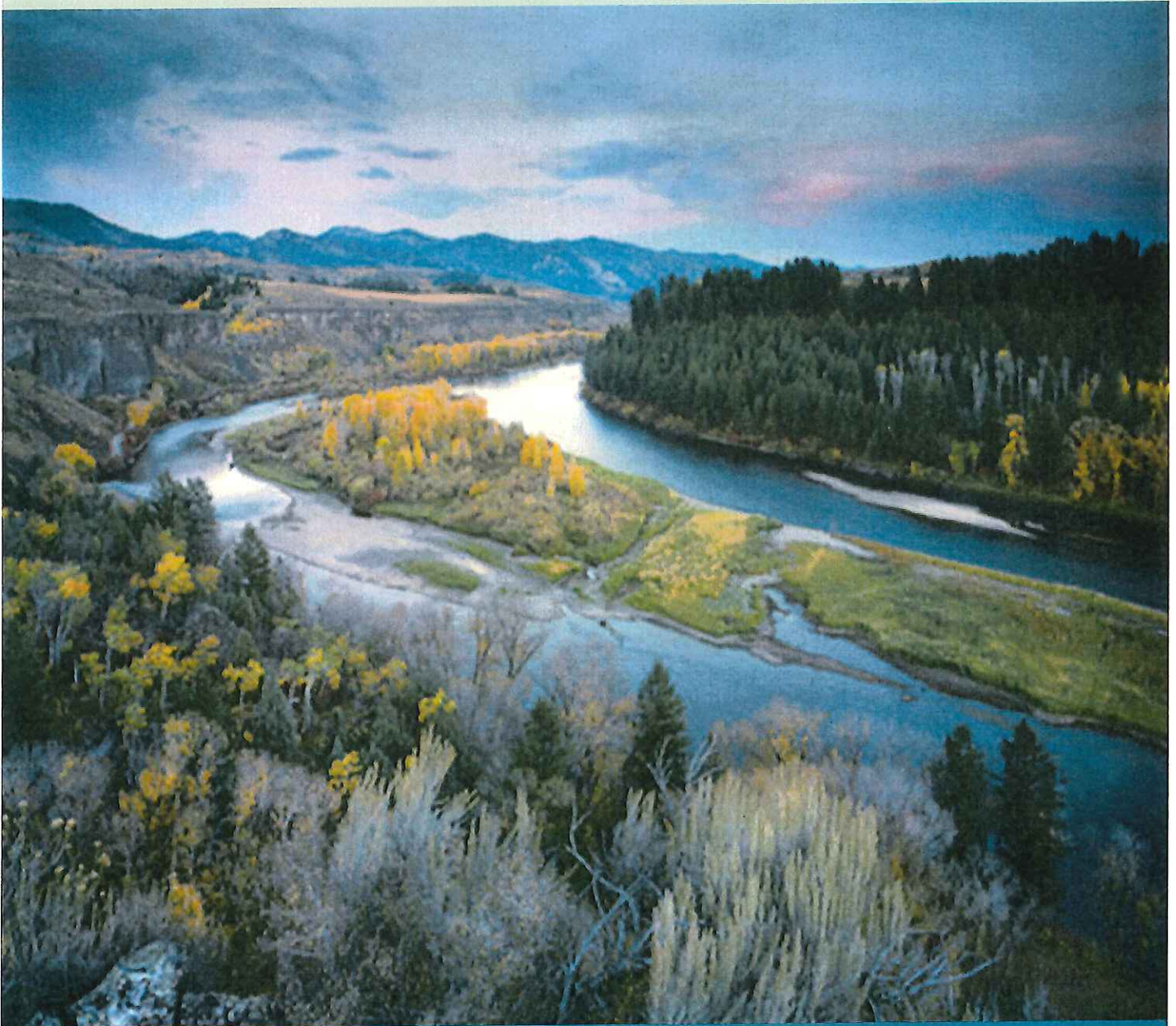

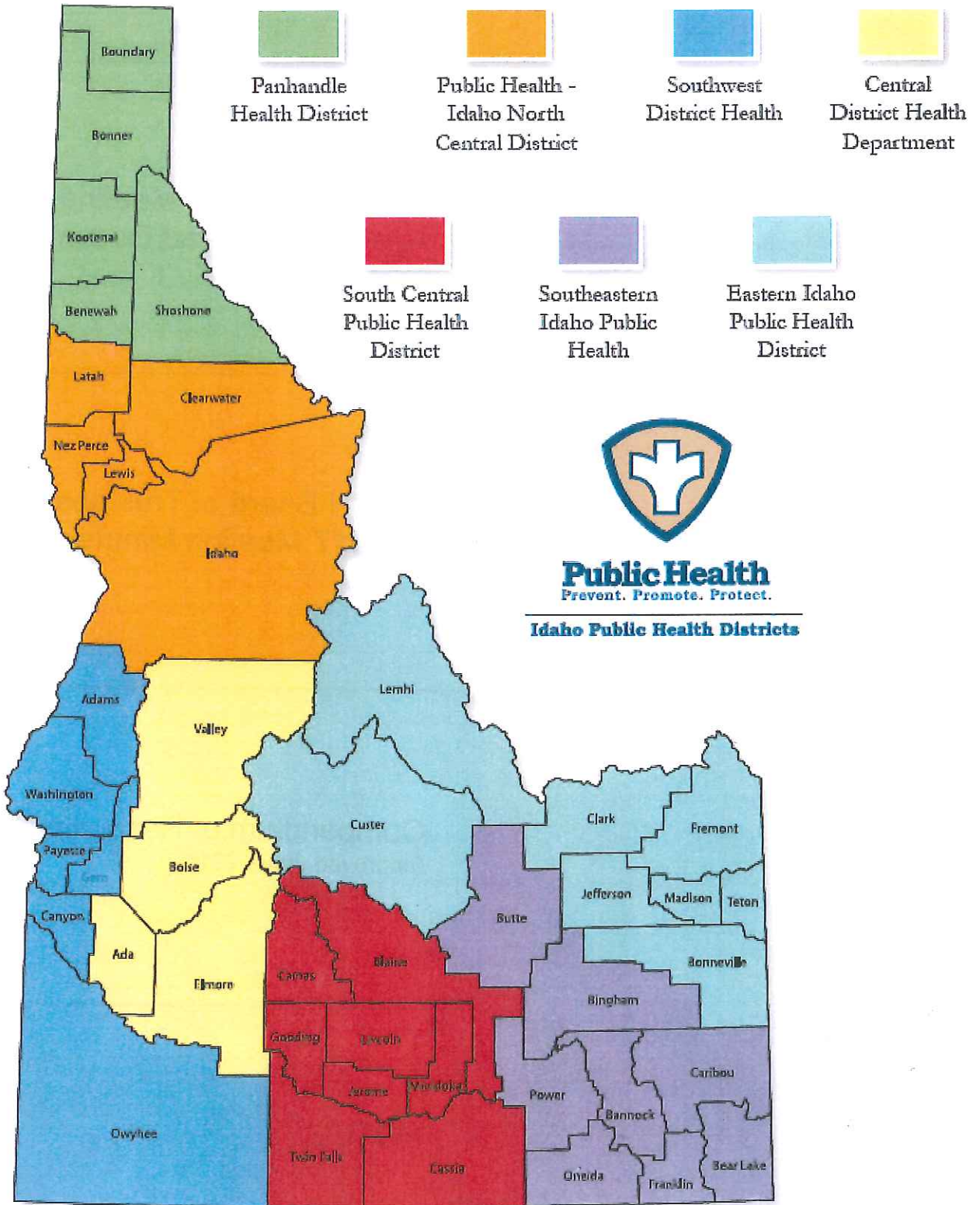

Dave Hanneman

Dave is the current Fire Chief of the Idaho Falls Fire Department. He has over 33 years of experience in fire protection systems, emergency management, firefighting and emergency medical services. Chief Hanneman holds an Associate's and Bachelor's Degree in Fire Service Technology from Boise State University and a Master's Degree in Professional Technical Education from the University of Idaho. In 2008, Chief Hanneman was designated Chief Fire Officer from the Center for Public Safety Excellence. He has been an Adjunct Faculty for National University in their Homeland Security program and is currently an Adjunct Faculty with Idaho State University in Fire Science. He also chairs the NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) Committee on Incident Management Team Qualification.



Bill Leake

Bill proudly served in the U.S Navy Nuclear Submarine Service from 1970 to 1976. After earning his Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering, he worked as a Consulting Engineer, eventually taking a job with the U.S. Department of Energy, working in a variety of leadership position at the Idaho National Laboratory, from where he retired in 2008. In 1996 when Logan was born, his mother had no idea the challenges that lay ahead with her newborn son. Logan grew up in Idaho Falls, was raised with three siblings, and had a very typical childhood. Panhandle Health District (PHD1)

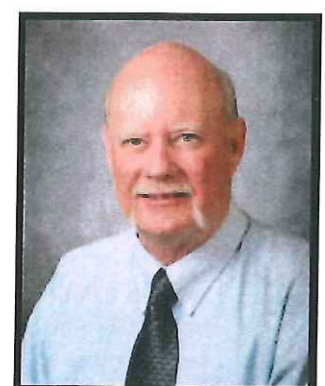
