This letter is to inform you of the changes that are being made to the Septic Permit fees and applicable land development fees for Eastern Idaho Public Health District beginning May 29, 2007. The changes were adopted by our District's Board of Health on May 17, 2007.

SEPTIC PERMITS

Application Fee \$ 125.00

Note* Application fee may be paid separately if type system is unknown, or permit fee may be included with application fee.) (Application fee includes \$ 55.00 non-refundable processing fee and \$ 70.00 onsite fee.)

Standard and Basic Alternative Systems (Total Price of permit \$260.00)	\$ 135.00
Complex System (Total Price of Permit \$ 380.00)	\$ 255.00
Large System [Community/Central/Large Soil Absorption System (LSAS)] (Total Price of Permit \$ 1,012.00)	\$ 887.00
Tank Only for connection to Central System (Permit included with Application fee) (Total Price of Permit \$125.00)	\$ 0.00

LAND DEVELOPMENT FEE

For subdivisions or plats for which sewage will be discharged to a central/community/LSAS, the fee shall be one hundred dollars (\$100) plus twenty dollars (\$20) per lot. The \$100.00 will be collected at time of application; the \$20.00 per lot will be collected at final signature.
