COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: Should I use disinfectant wipes on my hands?

Answer: It is important that people don't use disinfectant wipes on their hands instead of soap and water or hand sanitizer. Wipes are filled with harsh chemicals and it'll hurt your hands. In addition, it causes your skin to dry out and your skin cells to breakdown, creating cracks in your skin—putting you more at risk for being infected if your hands were to come in contact with germs. It is recommended that you rinse off your hands with water after you use a disinfectant wipe. Wipes are great for cleaning surfaces but please do not use them on your hands.
