COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: Can COVID-19 spread through water, like in a swimming pool or hot tub?

Answer: CDC says there is no evidence that COVID-19 can be spread to humans through the use of pools and hot tubs. Proper operation, maintenance, and disinfection (e.g., with chlorine and bromine) of pools and hot tubs should remove or inactivate the virus that causes COVID-19. But health officials still advise staying at least 6 feet away from others because COVID-19 is a respiratory disease. In other words, you probably won't get COVID-19 from the water, but you could get it from someone close to you in the water. As for drinking water, doctors say you don't need to worry about SARS-CoV-2 (the virus that causes COVID-19) in tap water because most municipal drinking water systems should remove or inactivate the virus.
