COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: How Do I Correctly Wear a Face Covering?

Answer: Before touching the covering, clean hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.

Take the covering and inspect it for tears or holes.

Orient which side is the top side (where the metal strip possibly is if wearing a covering with a strip).

Ensure the proper side of the covering faces outwards.

Place the covering to your face. Pinch the metal strip or stiff edge of the covering so it molds to the shape of your nose.

Pull down the covering's bottom so it covers your mouth and your chin.

Do not touch the covering while you are wearing it for protection.

After use, take off the covering with clean hands; remove the elastic loops from behind the ears while keeping the covering away from your face and clothes, to avoid touching potentially contaminated surfaces of the covering.

Discard the covering in a closed bin immediately after use. Wash the face covering between uses.

Perform hand hygiene after touching the covering – Use alcohol-based hand rub or, if visibly soiled, wash your hands with soap and water.
