### COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

**Question:** What new symptoms have been added to the list of COVID-19 symptoms?

**Answer:** CDC has long said that fever, cough and shortness of breath are indications that someone might have COVID-19. It has now added six more conditions that may come with the disease: chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat and new loss of taste or smell. The expanded symptoms list could prove important because with a limited number of test kits available, typically those seeking a test must first show symptoms. The symptoms usually appear within two to 14 days after exposure to the virus, CDC says. The virus (SARS-CoV-2) that causes COVID-19 has proved highly contagious and potentially deadly, but many of the people who become infected will show either no symptoms or only mild ones. The U.S., which has the highest number of confirmed cases in the world, is poised to cross the 1 million mark in coming days, with the number of deaths from the disease surpassing the annual death toll for pneumonia and flu, says CDC.
