COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: Is it safe to order take-out?

Answer:

According to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), there have not been any cases of COVID-19 known to be caused from eating food or handling food packaging. Here are some steps you can follow to help protect yourself when ordering groceries or carryout: 1) Before ordering groceries or carryout, check to see if you can pay online or over the phone, 2) Ask the delivery person to leave your packages at the door or on the porch, 3) If you go in person and curbside pickup is not available, make sure you maintain 6 feet of distance between you and the cashier, 4) Because carryout bags and containers have been touched recently by others, it is important to wash your hands after handling these, 5) Dispose of all packaging, and wash your hands again before eating.
