COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: If other criteria are met, what businesses can re-open during Stage 2?

Answer: If there are no significant increases in cases and other criteria remain met, Stage 2 is set to begin in Idaho on Saturday, May 16. Restaurant dining rooms can open once their plans have been submitted for approval by local public health districts. Indoor gyms and recreation facilities and close contact services (hair, nail, tattoo, massage, etc.) can open if they are able to meet business safety protocols. Bars and nightclubs remain closed along with large entertainment venues during Stage 2. If there are no significant changes during Stage 2, Stage 3 is set to begin on May 30.
