
### Positive COVID-19 Test Results

### COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

**Question:** Are businesses planning to re-open in Stage 2 of Idaho Rebounds required to submit a re-opening plan to public health? What about food establishments?

**Answer:** During Stage 2, which is slated to begin on May 16, specific businesses are scheduled to re-open (if they so choose) with some industries having specific guidance on how to re-open safely. These industry specific guidance documents can be found here: <https://rebound.idaho.gov/business-specific-protocols-for-opening/>. It is recommended, for the safety of their employees and customers, to have disease reducing strategies in place. However, there is no requirement for businesses to submit these plans to public health for approval.

Dine-in services for food establishments are being asked that prior to re-opening they submit a plan to their local health department to ensure their plans meet the criteria for safe operations. Information on how to submit the plan and what the plan should include can be found here:
