Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Case #49: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a female in her 20s in Jefferson County. This individual was not hospitalized and is recovering at home. Community transmission of COVID-19 is identified as the source of exposure.

COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: What are the main changes from Stage 1 to Stage 2 of Idaho Rebounds?

Answer: First, more businesses are allowed to re-open in Stage 2 including indoor gyms, recreational facilities, restaurant dining rooms, and close contact services (hair, nail, massage, cosmetic, tattoos). Bars, nightclubs, and large venues (movie theaters and sporting venues) remain closed. Also, visits to senior living facilities and congregate facilities (jails and prisons) remain prohibited.

Second, all vulnerable Idahoans should continue to self-quarantine and family members living in the same household should take precautions to isolate from vulnerable family members.

Third, gatherings, both public and private of less than 10 people, can occur as long as people practice social distancing. Non-essential travel should be minimized. Also, there should be a 14-day self-quarantine for people entering the state from areas experiencing substantial community transmission of COVID-19.
