### COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

**Question:** During a pandemic, what factors are taken into considerations when deciding to cancel an event??

**Answer:** Cancelling an event is never easy and comes only after deliberate consideration of many factors with the ultimate focus being on the health and safety of all involved. These factors might include: the overall number of attendees or crowd size, the number of attendees who are at higher risk of developing serious illness from COVID-19 including older adults and people with underlying health problems, how close together attendees will be at the event and the ability to social distance, amount of disease transmission in the local community and the communities from where event attendees are traveling, needs and capacity of the local community to host or participate in your event, and the healthcare capacity of the local community to respond to an outbreak if one were to occur at the event.
