Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Case #52: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a female age 0-19 years in Madison County. This individual was not hospitalized and is recovering at home. Community transmission is identified as the source of exposure.

COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: Could antibodies from recovered patients be used as a treatment for COVID-19?

Answer: This approach is already being tested in about 20 randomized trials. The idea behind convalescent plasma or serum therapy, as it is known, is that it can take weeks for our bodies to produce enough antibodies to overcome a new virus. Injecting severely ill people with antibodies made by others who have recently recovered could help fight the virus in the meantime.
