COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: What is more likely – a successful vaccine or an effective drug?

Answer: We are likely to see several drugs approved for treating COVID-19 before any vaccine becomes available, but they won't be miracle cures. Currently, a drug called Remdesivir has received emergency use approval in the US based on initial results suggesting that it shortens recovery time, but it doesn't seem to reduce the number of deaths. A real game-changer would be a drug that helps people with severe COVID-19 recover. Unfortunately, no such drug has been developed yet. Human trials of several vaccines have already begun. There is no guarantee that these efforts will succeed, but many vaccine researchers are optimistic.
