Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Case #55: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a female in her 20s in Bonneville County. This individual is not hospitalized. Contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 has been identified as the source of exposure.

Case #56: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a male in his 50s in Bonneville County. This individual is not hospitalized. Contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 has been identified as the source of exposure.

COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: What are the implications of asymptomatic transmission of COVID-19?

One of the more challenging aspects of the COVID-19 pandemic has been the prevalence of asymptomatic cases, or people who are infected with the virus and can spread it to others but do not feel sick. If you're able to transmit the virus while asymptomatic, it allows for a lot more community spread. For other viruses, you're not contagious until you have symptoms, so it's easier to screen for the disease and limit these chains of infection. COVID-19 is proving much harder to contain.
