COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: What are the primary modes of transmission for SARS-CoV-2 (the virus that causes COVID-19)?

Answer: According to CDC, the primary and most important mode of transmission for COVID-19 is through close contact (< 6' for >10 minutes) from person-to-person. Based on data from lab studies on COVID-19 and what we know about similar respiratory diseases, it is possible that a person can get COVID-19 by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it and then touching their own mouth, nose, or possibly their eyes, but this isn't thought to be the main way the virus is spread.
