Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Case #43: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a female in her 50s in Madison County. This individual was not hospitalized and is recovering at home. Community transmission of COVID-19 is identified as the source of exposure.

Case #44: We are reporting a positive COVID-19 test result for a female in her 20s in Madison County. This individual was not hospitalized and is recovering at home. Close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 is identified as the source of exposure.

COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: Will taking ibuprofen for fever/pains/aches while you have COVID-19 worsen symptoms?

Answer: The short answer is that there is no data to support that ibuprofen could worsen COVID-19 symptoms. Leading health and medical organizations are now saying there is no evidence to support the suggestion that ibuprofen might worsen the symptoms of COVID-19. According to Harvard Medical School, the concerns are based only on observations, not scientific studies.
