COVID-19 Q & A of the Day

Question: How long does it take to show symptoms after you have been exposed to COVID-19?

Answer: Symptoms could appear as soon as two days after exposure to as long as 14 days later, according to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). A study led by researchers at Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health provides a median time of about five days. That is why the 14-day quarantine period is used by CDC for people with likely exposure to the virus (SARS-CoV2) that causes COVID-19.
