Health Advisory Lifted for Henrys Lake and Upper Island Park Reservoir

(Fremont County) – Eastern Idaho Public Health and the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) have lifted a health advisory for Henrys Lake and Upper Island Park Reservoir. After two consecutive weeks of sampling at common access areas, DEQ confirmed that blue-green algae levels have fallen below concentrations of concern.

The public should avoid any isolated areas of algae, which may look like floating white-gray-blue paint, and should contact DEQ at (208) 528-2650 to report any areas of concern.
