Idaho Incident Based Reporting System

- County and jurisdiction level administrative statistics
- 1974 to current
- All criminal/consequence data
- Sensitive to funding and policing policies

DHW – Vital Statistics/DHW – Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance Survey (BRFSS)

- County (sometimes community) level administrative statistics
- 2003 to current
- Mortality and some morbidity
- Data is sensitive to change due to small numbers
- County level survey statistics (typically must be aggregated)
- 2001 to 2010, 2011 to current
- Drug, alcohol and tobacco use
- Survey methodology change

- 2012 to current
- Student based longitudinal data system
- FERPA limits degree of data that can be released

- Tony Jones
- Aggregate administrative statistics by county
- 2009 to current
- Treatment data based on drug of choice (primary and secondary)
- Sensitive to funding

Crash Information Retrieval Collection and Analysis system (CIRCA)

- All crashes that occur on public roadways resulting in an injury of more than \$1,500 down to the city level
- 1987 to current
- Alcohol involved crashes
- Policing limitations

Idaho Prevention and Treatment Research (PATR)

- 2007-2009... soon to be 2006-2012
- Risk factor based data
- Maps make comparison easy, narrow time
- makes trends difficult
