1. WELCOME and INTRODUCTIONS

2. PARTNERSHIP FOR SUCCESS (PFS) GRANT ORIENTATION DISCUSSION

- The group reviewed the first half of the proposed strategic action plan and were provided a grant history and outcomes for the first year. The group was informed of the necessary required elements of the grant that cannot currently be removed and the desire to include as many comprehensive and impactful action items as possible.
- Upon reviewing the first half of the document through the goals and objectives, a suggestion was given to add a more measurable outcome for the 2nd parent goal that included a percentage of change of the number of youth who report their parents provided alcohol to them. This change was made to the draft document.
- Shane Boyle provided information on a Tier 2 intervention called 3rd Millennium that was previously paid for by Juvenile Corrections and indicated that many Idaho schools were using the program online as an option for youth who have violated a policy at school for underage drinking. He also indicated that it was an evidence-based program. More information on this program will be presented at the next meeting.
- There was discussion about the Sticker Shock campaign and ideas on how to broaden its scope in the community. Some ideas for locations of the campaign include local rodeos, beer festivals, and other events where alcohol consumption is present. This item will be further discussed at the next meeting.

- Complete strategic plan, update current budget to reflect strategic plan, and send updates to the State through a project adjustment. Plan budget for Year 3 due by April 2020.
